webservice user guide

1. Introduction

A variety of free tools is offered by greeknamedays.gr to all developers or webmasters to add greek namedays and holidays on their websites, blogs or applications.

For those that need more, greeknamedays.gr offers a webservice to satisfy any needs regarding greek namedays and holidays. The webservice is not free and requires a username and password, given to users upon agreement/payment.

You can get greek namedays by name and by initial (leading letter of a name). Also you can get greek namedays and holidays by month and date. These are explained in detail in the following sections.

2. By Name

Search/Get greek namedays for a given name or part of a name.

2.1. Parameters

Parameters	Status	Description
u	<i>mandatory</i>	username
p	<i>mandatory</i>	password
langid	<i>optional</i>	output language default value: gr options: gr, en (Greek, English)
cyear	<i>mandatory</i>	year of interest i.e.: 2012
cname	<i>mandatory</i>	name of interest part or entire name, at least 3 characters, greek or latin characters only

3. By Initial

Search/Get greek namedays for a given initial, leading letter of a name.

3.1. Parameters

Parameters	Status	Description
u	<i>mandatory</i>	username
p	<i>mandatory</i>	password
langid	<i>optional</i>	output language default value: gr options: gr, en (Greek, English)
cyear	<i>mandatory</i>	year of interest i.e.: 2012
ab	<i>mandatory</i>	initial – leading letter of name only 1 character, greek or latin character only

Search/Get greek namedays and holidays for a given month.

4.1. Parameters

Parameters	Status	Description
u	<i>mandatory</i>	username
p	<i>mandatory</i>	password
langid	<i>optional</i>	output language default value: gr options: gr, en (Greek, English)
cyear	<i>mandatory</i>	year of interest i.e.: 2012
cmonth	<i>mandatory</i>	month of interest options: 1 - 12 integer, no leading zeros (0)

5.1. Parameters

Parameters	Status	Description
u	<i>mandatory</i>	username
p	<i>mandatory</i>	password
langid	<i>optional</i>	output language default value: gr options: gr, en (Greek, English)
cyear	<i>mandatory</i>	year of interest i.e.: 2012
cmonth	<i>mandatory</i>	month of interest options: 1 – 12 integer, no leading zeros (0)
cday	<i>Mandatory</i>	day of interest options: 1 – 31 integer, no leading zeros (0)
